

- 1. ONE IN FAITH: ABCD provides education and formation for seminarians, clergy, deacons and religious.
- 2. ONE IN HOPE: ABCD supports ministries, evangelization and faith formation.
- 3. ONE IN CHARITY: ABCD assists parishes and people in poor communities and support social ministries.
- 4. UNIVERSAL CHURCH: ABCD funds the work of the Church above and beyond what happens in each parish. ABCD brings hope and the love of Christ to others regardless of who they are or where they live.



PASTOR:

- Encourages active participation and sacrificial giving in the ABCD campaign.
- Maintains a positive outlook and perspective on ABCD and its importance in the Archdiocese of Miami.
- Tailors homilies and other communication platforms to ABCD, including showing the ABCD video during Commitment Weekend at all Masses.
- Coordinates with the ADOM Development Office to ensure the proper execution pf the ABCD campaign.

ARCHDIOCESE OF MIAMI DEVELOPMENT OFFICE:

- Acts as a bridge between the Archdiocese of Miami and the parish with 24/7 support to the parishes on their ABCD needs.
- Collaborates with the Pastor and parish team to ensure a smooth and successful ABCD appeal and campaign.
- Provides resources, materials, information, and support throughout the ABCD campaign.
- Provides support to parishes regarding ABCD gift processing and beyond.
- · Provides training to parish staff on the ABCD campaign and process.
- Submits timely reports on ABCD gifts and progress towards the goal.

PARISH ABCD COORDINATOR:

- Supervises the ABCD process at the parish level.
- Ensures that ABCD materials are properly displayed and disseminated within the parish.
- Adds ABCD bulletin announcements and prayer of the faithful intercessions to each Mass, in accordance with the ABCD timeline.
- Reviews and inspects the ABCD material delivery for accuracy before Commitment Weekend, including testing the ABCD video.
- Keeps the ADOM Development Office updated on parishioner and new parishioner information throughout the year and communicates regularly on any ABCD-related issue, concern, or request.
- Reconciles ABCD pledges and gifts with the ADOM Development Office on a weekly basis.

PARISH VOLUNTEERS:

- Help prepare and display all materials for Commitment Weekend and Follow-Up Weekend before Masses.
- Assist with coordinating the in-pew process.
- Provide assistance as requested by the Pastor or Parish ABCD Coordinator.







PRFPARF

We encourage you to make full use of the resources available to you, and please remember that the ADOM Development Corporation is here to support you throughout the ABCD Campaign.

DELIVERY AND PREPARATION OF ABCD MATERIALS

During the week of December 16th, each parish will receive a package of ABCD materials that should reflect the quantities that you requested. Materials are prepared in quantities of 250 so if you requested an amount that did not round to 250, then we rounded up based on the specific quantity you requested.

Upon receiving the materials, we ask that you carefully review the contents of the package to ensure that the parish materials order was accurately fulfilled. Please note-this includes testing the ABCD DVD using the same device that will be used during Masses. If you have any concerns or issues with any of the parish ABCD materials, please contact the Development Corporation at (305) 762-1054 immediately. Do not wait until the week before Commitment Weekend.

ABCD TRAINING SESSIONS

The ABCD Training Sessions provide ABCD Coordinators with crucial information about the upcoming ABCD campaign, including the steps for processing ABCD gifts. All training dates and times are available on the ABCD Important Dates page, so please register for your preferred training as soon as possible. ABCD training is required unless you receive an exemption from the Development Office.

WEEK OF JANUARY 6TH

- Archbishop's ABCD letter mailed to all parishioners.
- ABCD Materials Display display ABCD posters, pledge envelopes and brochures, etc.
- Prepare bulletin announcements and prayer of the faithful intercessions for this weekend.
- Add ABCD logo and link to ABCD website on your Parish website.
- ABCD Training offered on January 9th.



WEEKEND OF JANUARY 11-12

ABCD INTRODUCTION WEEKEND

- The Pastor announces the upcoming ABCD campaign, including the anticipation of the Archbishop's letter that should be received by the parishioners in the upcoming week.
- Bulletin announcements and prayer of the faith intercessions begin this weekend.
- Pastor takes this moment to express the importance of ABCD, what it supports, why it is essential to contribute, etc.
- Conclude Mass with a powerful testimonial from a witness, such as a seminarian, ministry representative, or someone involved in respect life (refer to the Speaker Pool) who can share their personal experiences and how ABCD has positively influenced their lives. This testimonial can also be from one of the parish's top or most consistent donor(s) to the ABCD to talk about why they give and what it means to them.

WEEK OF JANUARY 13TH

- Refresh ABCD Materials Display- brochures, pledge envelopes, etc.
- Prepare bulletin announcements and prayer of the faithful intercessions for this weekend.
- Begin promoting ABCD on social media and through other communications mediums.
- ABCD Training offered on January 14th.

JANUARY 18-19 ANNOUNCEMENT WEEKEND

- From the pulpit, the Pastor talks about stewardship at an archdiocesan level, and charity must extend beyond what happens at the parish level.
- The Pastor announces the ABCD from the Pulpit at all Masses to prayerfully consider what gift they will make next week at Mass. It is important to talk about what ABCD is and how it serves our Catholic community, as well as share the ABCD parish goal, etc.
- Make sure there are ample ABCD brochures and pledge envelopes in the pews for parishioners to review.
- Bulletin announcements and prayer of the faith intercessions continue (see bulletin announcements & prayer of the faithful intercessions).
- Insert the ABCD Flyer/into all the Bulletins for each Mass.
- Conclude Mass with a powerful testimonial from a witness (different speaker from last week), such as a seminarian, ministry representative, or someone involved in respect life (refer to the Speaker Pool) who can share their personal experiences and how ABCD has impacted their lives.

WEEK OF JANUARY 20TH

- Refresh ABCD Materials Display- brochures, pledge envelopes, etc.
- Prepare bulletin announcements and prayer of the faithful intercessions for this weekend.
- Continue to promoting ABCD on social media and through other communications mediums.
- ABCD weekly reports begin on Wednesday, January 22nd.

JANUARY 25-26 COMMITMENT WEEKEND

- Pledge Envelopes and brochures in all pews for all Masses.
- Bulletin announcements and prayer of the faith intercessions continue (see bulletin announcements & prayer of the faithful intercessions).
- Under the leadership of your pastor, the in-pew appeal plays a very important role in the overall success of the Archbishop's Charity and Development Drive (ABCD). The following points outline the recommended process to conduct the in-pew appeal on Commitment Weekend:
 - During the homily the Celebrant should incorporate a message of returning gifts to God in return for his abundant blessings through the ABCD. The homily will stress the importance of the Appeal to the Archdiocese and the ministries that benefit from funds it raises.
 - The ABCD Video should be shown during the Homily or after Communion.
 - During the in-pew appeal, the pastor should make his own commitment, modeling the act of stewardship for others.
 - Please share the parish's dollar goal and participation goal. Ask all individuals/households to commit to the ABCD. Express the importance of 100% participation as the parish's commitment to stewardship. Note that no gift is too small.
 - Guide parishioners through the process of completing the pledge envelope, which can then be torn from the envelope and inserted into it, along with any cash or checks.
 - Invite all to place their pledge/envelopes into the Offertory. Celebrant should do the same.

WEEK OF JANUARY 27TH


- Refresh ABCD Materials Display- brochures, pledge envelopes, etc.
- Prepare bulletin announcements and prayer of the faithful intercessions for this weekend.
- Recognize your ABCD donors (unless they have asked to be Anonymous) in your bulletin for the weekend.
- Add ABCD video to your website.
- If you have an electronic newsletter and/or text to give option, now is the time to email the ABCD video with a link appeal to your parishioners.
- Continue to promoting ABCD on social media and through other communications mediums.

FEBRUARY 1-2 FOLLOW-UP WEEKEND

- Pledge Envelopes and brochures in all pews for all Masses.
- Bulletin announcements and prayer of the faith intercessions continue.
- At Homily time, parishioners are asked to fill-out a pledge envelope if they did not do so previously.
- Pastor thanks those who have responded generously while providing a response on how close/far to their goal they are.
- Recognize the donors to the ABCD in your bulletin.
 (If not this week, then in the weeks to follow.) Be sure to not include those who requested to remain anonymous.

WEEKS FOLLOWING THE ABCD APPEAL

- Continue to refresh the ABCD materials in the pews.
- Continue to promote on social media and through your communication mediums.
- Continue to recognize the ABCD donors in the bulletin (unless anonymous).
- Update your parishioners on ABCD progress towards goal.



PARISH GIFT PROCESSING

Gift processing is either done at the parish or by the Development Office. If your parish does not have the resources to process their ABCD donations, the Development Office will do it for you.

Regardless of whether ABCD donations are processed at the parish or at the development office, there are very important steps and guidelines for ABCD gift processing. ABCD training is essential to understanding the gift processing procedure.

Parish processing of ABCD donations is permitted using the online processing platform until February 28th. After February 28th, all ABCD donations must be processed by the Development Office.

This is the Processing Map for Parish Gift Processing:

ADOM PROCESSING FOR THE PARISH

To provide support to parishes, the Development Office offers assistance with ABCD gift processing. It is crucial for parishes to follow the necessary steps to prepare pledges and gifts for processing before sending them to the Pastoral Center. Refer to the ADOM processing for the parish map here:

Place all separated envelopes into Tamper Evident Bags by Category.
Please note that each Tamper Evident Bag should be labeled by Category and separated by Gift Type.

Deliver to Development Office by approved delivery methods. All packages sent to Development Office for ABCD should be insured/bonded & trackable.


PROCESSING AFTER FEBRUARY 28TH

To ensure seamless pledge billing, it is imperative that all gifts, particularly pledges, are processed and recorded prior to the first pledge billing report in the first week of March. By adhering to this processing map, parishes can avoid any delays or challenges in pledge billing and gift processing.

PROCESS VALID FROM MARCH 1ST UNTIL THE CLOSE OF CAMPAIGN

**IMPORTANT NOTE:

- * DO NOT separate Cash/ Check from Pledge Envelope. Please send the envelopes with original content
- * DO NOT deposit any cash or checks.
- * DO NOT use staples, only paper clips when necessary.



STEP 2

Scan or Copy each pledge
envelope for your record keeping.
Deposit all Cash and Checks
into Parish Account.
Place all separated original pledge
envelopes along with corresponding
Batch Reports and Parish Check into
Tamper Evident Bags. Please note
that each Tamper
Evident Bag should be labeled
by Category and separated
by Gift Type.

STEP 3

Deliver to Development Office by approved delivery methods. All packages sent to Development Office for ABCD should be insured/bonded & trackable.

ABCD REPORTING

The Development Office is dedicated to providing high-quality reporting services, continually assessing and enhancing our offerings through innovative solutions. Presently, ABCD Reporting is facilitated via our third-party partner, GivingTrend.

Through GivingTrend, you and your parish staff have secure access to your real-time ABCD donations. This platform empowers you to conveniently view and download a diverse range of reports. These reports can be easily downloaded in printable formats or exported to spreadsheets. Additionally, ABCD reports are emailed to parishes weekly.



It is highly recommended that parishes reconcile the ABCD reports received on a weekly basis. Upon review, if you have any questions or concerns with your ABCD report, please contact the Development Office as soon as possible.

Moreover, the Development Office stands ready to assist parishes with customized reports throughout the year. Examples of reports that may be requested by the parish include:

- Complete Donor Report: This comprehensive report provides up-to-date donor information for any campaign, including details on whether the donor has chosen to remain anonymous.
- Appeal Prospecting: Utilize this report to identify LYBUNTS (Last Year but Not This Year), allowing targeted follow-up with donors who contributed to the previous year's appeal but have not yet contributed this year. This report proves invaluable for fostering continued engagement.
- SYBUNTS (Some Years but Not This Year): This report helps identify donors who contributed to the appeal in previous years but have not contributed this year. It assists in tailoring outreach efforts to reconnect with these individuals.

BULLETIN ANNOUNCEMENTS PLAY A CRUCIAL ROLE in engaging and informing our parishioners about the importance and significance of the ABCD Campaign. These announcements serve as a means of communication, connecting us as a community and inspiring us to take action. Below are several options to choose from for the 2025 ABCD:


